### **Fisheries**

Fishers Green. Water levels for most of the season were low but many good fish were banked mostly as the light started to go. Just prior to Christmas an 8lbs+ chub came out, with the rains giving coloured water and nearly 4 hours of darkness currently allowed conditions could not be better.

*Pike are being caught from the pits but nothing big reported yet.*

Turnford complex Railway has produced fish to 40lbs Boot pit has also fished really well with multiple catches of fish from 5lbs to 20lbs Lea and Marsh have produced some good fish but are not heavily fished.

Forty hall Earlier in the summer low water levels caused problems but a bit of work on the ditch and pipe improved the situation and the lake fished superb throughout the season
