FISHERIES

Two new fisheries on the book for this season The New river opens on the 16th June whilst the Woodlands lake at Forty hall starts 1st April.

Forty hall will work on a booking system each club has six swims each day so any member wishing to fish must phone me before, bookings will be taken starting seven days before planned visit.

Anyone fishing without a booking will receive a ban, and anyone booking and then not using the booking without cancelling the latest the night before will also not be able to book again until the night prior to a visit.

A walk around the fishery this week saw plenty of fish on the move so lets hope the warmer weather holds for a few weeks.

Passingford was poor last week but this week again with the sun putting in an appearance fish were on the munch and two members had a good day with Rudd and Roach to a pound banked and the first Tench of the season.

The river Lea, and both relief channels are now closed until 16th June but the pits at the Green are open 24hours a day all year round. A good number of Pike have been banked in the last month.

Turnford is also starting to wake up Carp and Bream showing an interest in feeding.
